


What to expect when publishing Open Access via a Publish and Read agreement

Our aim is to make the process of publishing an article Open Access under a Publish and Read agreement as easy as possible and to achieve this we have partnered with Copyright Clearance Center.

Below is a visualization of the process and requirements for authors from submission through to publication and approval instructions for library admins. Authors submitting a manuscript with a P&R eligible institutional email domain and affiliation will be recognised by the peer review system and need only select Open Access publication and confirm their eligibility.

The process is also as transparent and light-touch as possible for library admins (our primary contact, to be registered in CCC RightsLink Agreement Manager, our Open Access transaction portal).

Once registered with the CCC RightsLink system, you will be able to view accepted manuscripts and pull reports on articles that are published under the Publish and Read deal in your Agreement Manager account. Our strong preference is for library administrators to switch on auto-approval on the CCC RightsLink portal; otherwise, the default settings on the platform requires manual 'approval' by the Institution of accepted manuscripts. As our Publish and Read deal is unlimited, there is no paydown fund for you to manage. The Author must enter their Publish and Read eligible institutional email and affiliation in the Editorial manager submission system

The Author should indicate during submission that they are eligible for fee-free Open Access publication via a Publish and Read agreement between their institution and the Microbiology Society.

There are two possible routes to publishing Open Access with the Microbiology Society:

- Fee-free Open Access through Publish and Read:**
You are eligible for fee-free Open Access if:
 - You are based at an institution listed here: www.microbiologyresearch.org/fee-free-open-access.
 - You submit using your institutional email address
 If you fulfill **both** criteria above, you will be automatically included. Please confirm your eligibility by clicking "View Publication Charges" below to see the full discount applied. For more information on Publish and Read, please see here: www.microbiologyresearch.org/publish-and-read
- Open Access through paying an Article Processing Charge (APC):**
If you are not eligible for Open Access via a Publish and Read agreement, you will be asked to pay an Article Processing Charge (APC).
